- A wristwatch (the crystal quartz wristwatch was invented in 1927)
- A baseball or bat (In 1927 Babe Ruth hit 60 homeruns, a record that stood for 34 years)
- A piece of Scotch Tape (In 1925, Richard G Drew invented Scotch Tape)
- A picture or logo of Route 66 (created in 1926)
- A Newbery award winning book (The Newbery was proposed by Frederic G. Melcher in 1921, making it the first children's book award in the world)
- A hair dryer (invented in 1920)
- A band-aid (invented in 1920)
- A Q-Tip (invented in 1920)
- A glass beverage bottle
- An electric shaver (invented in 1928)
- A coin from the 1920s
- A glass beverage bottle
- A hamburger bun (1st cheeseburger 1924)
- A piece of sliced bread (bread slicer invented in 1927)
- A blender (Invented in 1922)
- Anything with Mickey Mouse on it (Mickey made his debut in the short film Steamboat Willie (1928) which was one of the first sound cartoons)
- A packet of Kool-aid (invented in 1927)
- A box of Wheaties (invented in 1924)
- A package of Oscar Meyers Wieners (invented in 1929)
- A bag of Bird's Eye frozen vegetables (invented in 1928)
- A box of Kellogg's Rice Krispies (invented in 1928)
- A jar of Peter Pan Peanut Butter (invented in 1928)
- A can of Green Giant Canned Peas (invented in 1925)
- A leaf of spinach (In 1929, the cartoon character Popeye was created)
- A can of 7-Up (invented by Charles Leiper Grigg 1929)
