

On-site Supervised Distance Learning Program

Satori is providing free on-site supervised distance learning as mandated by the Governor in EO-2020-51.

On-site supervised distance learning will happen at the Charter Campus: 3727 N. 1st Ave.

Hours

- Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday: 8:30 AM to 3:00 PM (students may be dropped off starting at 8:15 AM and must be picked up by 3:15 PM)
- Wednesday: 8:30 AM – 2:00 PM (students may be dropped off starting at 8:15 AM and must be picked up by 2:00PM)

Satori will provide space and supervision for on-line and off-line activities during the day

Families may arrange for students to stay for any or all of the day, however there will be no Extended Care.

Please let us know of your intended schedule - daily drop-off and pick-up - so we can safely get students to and from to class.

Health and Safety

Students will need to bring and wear their masks.

- Everyone here at school, students and staff will be practicing social distancing, including the use of masks when indoors, except when necessary (for example, while eating or drinking), when we will enforce physical distancing.
- We will ensure there is appropriate ventilation in the learning space.
- We will use our outdoor spaces to let kids run around and get fresh air, etc.
- We have built in some safe “mask free” spaces and times out-of-doors for individuals who need that.

Families are expected to conduct daily health screenings according to the Satori Community Health Screening Agreement for COVID-19.

A staff member will conduct a screening for everyone entering campus.

Students will be dropped off at the pull-through in front of the Charter campus. A staff member will administer a health screening before anyone exits the vehicle. The student will be escorted into the building following handwashing and face covering protocols.

Only Satori staff and students will be permitted in the building without prior authorization.

Supervised Distance Learning

Satori has designated staff members to support the students.

Students will each be assigned a personal workspace with a computer. That workspace will be cleaned and disinfected according to a daily schedule.

Students should bring:

- Everything they need for all classes.
- A snack and a lunch if they plan to be here at lunch time. We will have supervised, socially distanced opportunities for our kids to eat.
- A water bottle. We have discontinued the use of our communal water fountains. We do have a water filtration system that a staff member will use to fill students' water bottles.
