Drop-off and Pick-up

Be careful! and **Drive slowly!**

- Our drop off and pick up routines are starting to work out their kinks. The biggest issue seems to be pickup at the charter campus. Families who pick up at the charter should **not** park in the pull through. If you arrive before 3:00 (2:00 on Wednesdays), please pull ahead into the south parking lot, park there, and walk to the gate (or the end of the sidewalk so we can see you). We will bring your child to you as soon as possible. Please be careful as there is a lot of traffic and students are moving on foot between campuses.
