Volunteers Needed!

Hello Satori Families,

On Saturday, November 20th, we will be working on our rainwater harvesting project and we need your help!

The rainwater harvesting project at Satori has been long in the making now. Satori students have been collaborating with the Watershed Management Group and Project WET to design a rainwater harvesting system using gutters and basins. Rainwater harvesting is being incorporated into our students' curriculum this year, and some of our 8th graders will be coming to younger classes and giving their own lessons on watersheds and rainwater harvesting.

We will be planting and mulching in our newly sculpted basins from 8am-1pm on November 20th, so stop by and help us out! Sign up here to come join the fun: [Watershed Volunteers](#)

This project is the result of a \$5000 grant from Watershed Management Group that Ann Peterson secured for Satori. With this grant they are helping us with the infrastructure to harvest rainwater that falls here at school. This will support a raingarden here at school with native plants where we can harvest runoff and provide food and shelter for butterflies, song birds, and other wildlife and to help recharge Tucson's valuable groundwater.

This could help fulfil the 20 hours of volunteer work requested of Satori families. We will provide some snacks and water, but if you are not attending, please consider donating some snacks or water or funds to help supplement the grant which covers the excavation and most of the gutters and other supplies. With more funds, we can develop our rainwater harvesting system even further and buy more plants.
