HOW TO SIGN UP

Registration will be online this year. The link with a password for access will be emailed to families Friday August 26th. Registration for after school activities will begin at 5PM Saturday and will continue online until 5PM, Wednesday August 31. Registration is first come first serve, and class sizes are limited.

After-school Activities and Extended Care Charges:

- If your child is not enrolled in Full-time Extended Care, you will be billed for Extended Care charges <u>in addition to the activity fee</u>:
 - o Preschool 1st Grade: \$7.00/hour
 - 2nd Grade 8th Grade. \$7.00/hour with a \$100.00 required deposit.
- These Extended Care charges accrue until you pick up your child each day.
- There is no credit given for activities fees when your child is absent. You will not be billed for the Extended Care time.

- All activities are billed monthly. Rates are based on the number of weeks per month and will vary according to the number of classes per month.
- Request for changes like dropping or adding an activity must be made prior to the beginning of a new month (or new activity session) by filling out a change of status sheet. These are available in the office.
- All changes take effect at the beginning of the following calendar month with no changes mid-month/mid-session.

CHESS CLUB (Private & Charter School)

Participants will have fun in chess matches and sharpen their thinking skills while learning and playing this fascinating, classic game. Pokémon TCG (Charter School)

RPG Club: Role Playing Games (Charter School)

Dungeons & Dragons is a structured, yet open-ended role-playing game where characters in the game are verbally acted out by players. A game often continues over a series of meetings to complete a single adventure, and longer into a series of related gaming adventures, called a "campaign". The students will learn how the system works, make a playable character in that system and then play an adventure in that world. RPG is a great way for students to explore a variety of social and other useful cognitive skills, such as logic, basic mathematics and imagination while having fun! *note- class size could go up if there was a volunteer that could take half the class.
